Flip Flop Bay is the sixth in a fantasy action-adventure set in the South Pacific.



The manuscript had been forgotten while working on other book projects – but wanting to do a book that she could enjoy with her husband's granddaughter, Milla, prompted her to dig out the manuscript. She is now working on book number six with input from Milla, and has more ideas for an ongoing series.

Karen was awarded a Creative NZ Grant to enable her to do a book tour in Brisbane Australia in August 2018, visiting schools and doing media interviews. She has also been invited to go to the Tauranga Arts Festival in October 2019.



'Oh,' said Blong, sounding glum.


