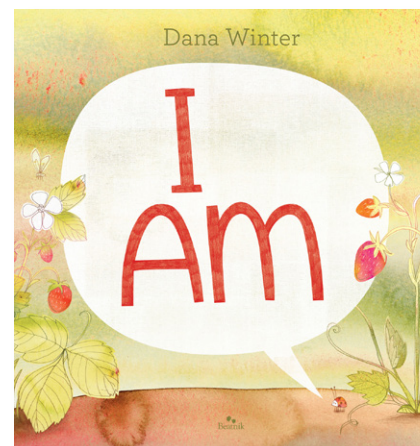

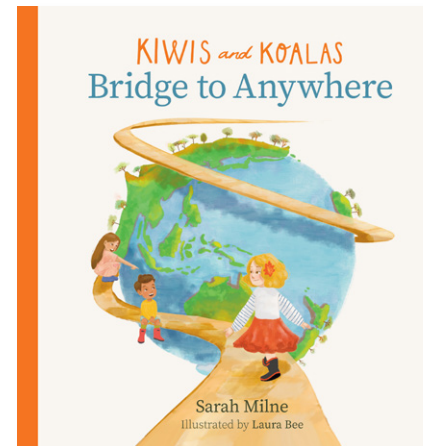

With her cousins visiting from overseas, Lily shares her magical bridge ... and this time they venture further than Australia. Where do you think they will visit and what do you think they will see?

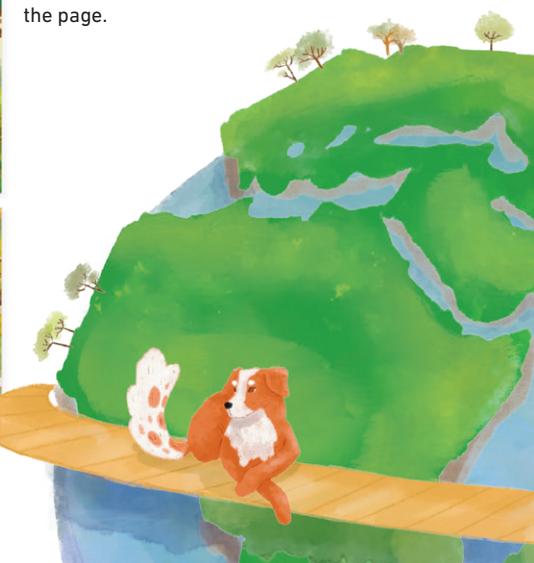
