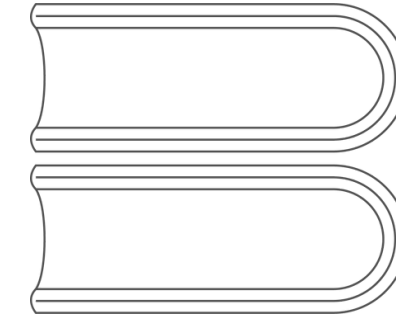

Hope Hogan, a young woman struggling through a difficult life while working at a Chinese restaurant alongside her best friend, begins to notice the appearance of a series of people who are as powerful as they are mysterious. Little by little, she discovers the existence of a hidden world of forces pulling the strings of reality, while unexpectedly finding herself caught in a love triangle between two captivating young men who could not be more different. What she doesn't yet realize is that they are among the most influential beings in the world: Adrian is the Magician, and Dante is the Devil. Under their influence, Hope's love life descends into chaos, while her personal life steadily falls apart, leaving her powerless to control her own destiny.

As the danger surrounding her grows, Hope learns the truth: she is the Anomaly, an unknown force that draws the Arcana of the Tarot to her, along with other dark entities that should have remained buried in the shadows. These sinister beings, known as the Reversed, believe she is the Chosen One, destined to lead them in destroying the Arcana so they can finally seize the throne of the Tower after centuries of waiting. In this deadly struggle for power, some will seek to win her trust, others will try to use her and many would rather see her dead.



JAVIER SANTOLOBO

Javier Santolobo is a writer, screenwriter, and journalist. He is the author of the self-published middle-grade science fiction series *Hearts of Iron*, which has become a benchmark in the genre and has captivated hundreds of thousands of readers around the world. He now presents *Fatum*, the first novel in the *Arcana* duology, marking his debut in contemporary YA dark fantasy.

As a screenwriter, he wrote the feature film *Nothing Will Ever Be the Same* (directed by Víctor Antolí, 2019), the award-winning mid-length film *Two Coins* (directed by Felipe Giuliano, 2023), and the acclaimed short film *CLAC CLAC CLAC* (directed by M.^a Teresa García, 2018).

Borja Cabada is an award-winning Spanish author, screenwriter, and illustrator whose career combines narrative talent, international recognition, and a deep love for storytelling.

A recipient of the prestigious Fulbright Scholarship in 2012, he earned his MA in Writing and Publishing from DePaul University in Chicago, one of the cultural capitals of the United States.

His first novel, *El sonido de Atlantis* (Algaida), won the Logroño Novel Prize for Young Writers in 2017, establishing him as one of the most promising emerging voices of his generation. He has contributed on several occasions to the popular science magazine for children *Principia Kids*, as well as to the American publisher KiwiCo, with whom he published his novella *Chasing Spanish Treasure* in 2023.

Los Bregonautas, his middle-grade debut, is a trilogy where mystery, magic, and friendship coexist with the occasional ghost up to its old tricks.

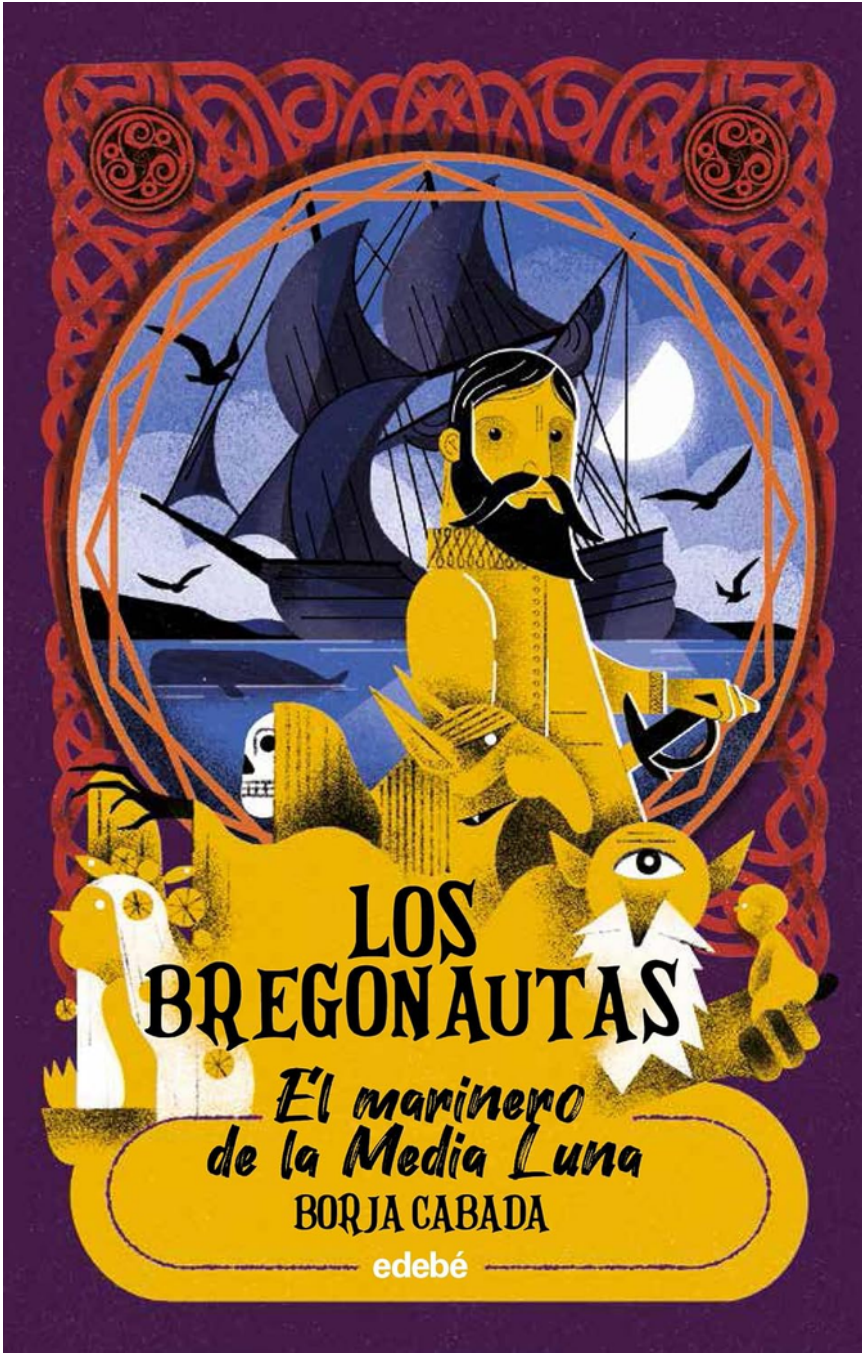
THE HALF-MOON SAILOR
