

#### Paradiso siciliano (Sicilian Paradise)



It is a rainy day in October 1948, when at the harbour of Stromboli a young woman in a much too large coat disembarks with a big suitcase from the postal ferry.

Her name is Ada Vittoria Valeri, and she came from Milan to work as an elementary school teacher.

Back in Milan Ada had met an American GI with whom she fell in love. He saved her from a friendless home, but when Ada realises that she is pregnant, he is gone. To avoid being the victim of malicious comments, she applies for a job in Sicily and is sent to Stromboli, which in 1947 is an island still without the blessings of civilisation as electricity or running water.

Soon her pupils adore her, but the priest and the small village community eye the young and beautiful single woman suspiciously. She pretends to be a widow and a few months later gives birth to a

girl, for whom she finds a wet nurse and continues to work as a teacher.

Everything changes when Stromboli becomes a film set. Until recently before Rossellini was involved with Anna Magnani, who was meant to play the lead role in his new film set on the island, but now he has fallen for Ingrid Bergmann, whom he lures there. The love between the Italian director and the Swedish actress arouses scandal everywhere, because both of them are still married and each of them has children with their partners.

The loss of her man and of the lead role is a double betrayal for the passionate Anna: she is heartbroken and offended in her pride. She does nothing to hide that she is seething with jealousy and rage. She meditates and prepares her bitter revenge.

In just a few weeks, in fact, on the nearby island of Vulcano, filming will begin on the eponymous film produced by Panaria, the new production company of the Sicilian prince Francesco Alliata di Villafranca. The prince, who with a specially created equipment was able to realise the first underwater filming ever worldwide, has entrusted his first feature film to the expert director William Dieterle: a movie that is meant to become a colossal with Magnani as protagonist. A movie that Anna herself wanted at all costs.

It will be "the war of the volcanoes", a race against time for two eagerly awaited films, and "the war of the divas". The paparazzi move en masse to the Aeolian Islands, bouncing from one island to another, from one set to another: in that torrid Sicilian summer of 1949 the situation on the islands is talking point in Europe and Overseas.

The two divas shoot their films on the neighbour volcano islands and wage their war for the man Roberto Rossellini. Soon Ada is going to be involved in this conflict: knowing some English thanks to her liaison with the GI, she is hired as an interpreter, and eventually, after becoming the personal assistant of Ingrid Bergmann, makes friends with the Swedish actress, visiting her often in her simple fisherman's house.

When some time later her love affair with Rossellini comes to an end, Bergmann writes once more a letter to Ada, who in the meantime has taken up with a photographer and moved back to the mainland, to Rome, where she became an acknowledged photographer herself.

But the allure of the island and its inhabitants and of the dramatic events during the filmings there will remain with her always.

This commercial upmarket women's novel is both a piece of film history (including gossip at its best!) and a post-war female empowerment saga, as Ada realises her talent and ambition becoming a successful photographer.

In the night between 17 and 18 August 1978, Dirk Hamer, a German boy full of life, was on a friend's boat off the island of Cavallo in Corsica.

Following an argument over the use of a dinghy, from a nearby boat on which Prince Vittorio Emmanuele di Savoia was sitting, a rifle fired and a shot hit the boy in the leg. Dirk died following a months-long suffering.

Tried by the Paris Court of Assizes, Vittorio Emmanuele was acquitted of the charge of manslaughter.

But in 2006 there was the sensational breakthrough: in an environmental interception ordered by the Public Prosecutor's Office in the Potenza prison cell where Vittorio Emanuele was imprisoned for another investigation, the Prince confided to his cellmate that it was he who had shot and hit Dirk. He boasted that with his 'battery of lawyers' he had fooled the French judge.

Having already been acquitted, Victor Emmanuel could not be prosecuted for the crime again.

Birgit Hamer decided to write this courageous tell-all book, later edited by journalist Beatrice Borromeo-Casiraghi, reconstructing in detail the Prince's responsibility.

After the first publication of Birgit Hamer's book, the prince filed a lawsuit against the publisher and the author. The trial dragged on for several years and finally the court ruled in their favour.

The story of Dirk, who was shot dead at the age of nineteen, is now back in the limelight thanks to the series Netflix has dedicated to the case.

A prince in exile. A shot in the dark.



# Silvio. La vita vera di Berlusconi (Silvio. The True Life of Berlusconi)



To understand what Berlusconi has represented for Italy, one must first of all know who Silvio, *il Cavaliere*, really was.

"A man of action", as he repeatedly called himself? The 'man of miracles', as he was described in life and afterwards by his worshippers? Or is he evil personified, as his hard-core adversaries, the anti-Berlusconians, are convinced? This biography helps to unravel the enigma of Berlusconi's personality.

This book is a journey through the life and career of one of the most discussed and controversial figures in Italian politics. A work that promises to shed light on little-known and often ignored aspects of the *Cavaliere*, from his childhood to his rise in the world of politics, passing through his passions and personal relationships.

This book, which in part was first published as *Guzzanti vs Berlusconi* in 2009 and in the meantime has become a kind of

'classic' biography of the *Cavaliere*, has been updated to the events of 2023 and Silvio Berlusconi's death. An account that is not at all complacent, indeed desecrating and at times fierce, but without the litany of usual, commonplace accusations.

Paolo Guzzanti, long-time journalist and most non-conformist mind of Italian journalism, offers a portrait of Berlusconi that goes beyond the usual accusations and praise.

The author, who in the past was convinced to recognize in the *Cavaliere* as a possible leader of an Italian liberal revolution, does not spare criticism and biting remarks. But this is not a biased book: Guzzanti, after realizing that his belief in Berlusconi was completely mistaken, offers a balanced and in-depth view.

Already in the times when he was Berlusconi's supporter, Guzzanti had sharply criticised the progressive hibernation of Parliament, the lack of internal party democracy in Forza Italia and the selection of political personnel according to criteria of sex appeal.

After having left the *Cavaliere*'s orbit, Guzzanti drew a very close, personal and indiscreet portrait of him, also retracing his family history through two long exclusive interviews with Berlusconi himself and his mother Rosa.

The interview that remained unpublished for a long time, is therefore the fil rouge of this irreverent book, which analyses the phenomenology of the *Cavaliere* from his childhood, youth and first jobs until the birth of Fininvest to the 'Segrate war' (the legal and financial war for the property of Mondadori publishing between Berlusconi e Carlo De Benedetti), passing through his entering the political arena and the many judicial troubles, without renouncing a dutiful excursus on the 'mignottocrazia' ('whore-cracy', a term coined by Guzzanti himself).

**Guzzanti's biography closes telling us about a last meeting with Silvio, in March 2023,** when by then the *Cavaliere*'s autumn had taken on the darkest colours of imminent farewell.





When she gets a phone call from Paris from her former professor (and ex lover) Altiero Roversi who needs her advise as a Casanova expert, Viola takes the next flight to join him. At her arrival, however, she finds out that a few hours before Altiero has been killed. Viola is immediately convinced that the reason for his death is a manuscript discovered by him and apparently to be contributed to

Casanova, and which now has disappeared. She leaves for Castle Dux in Bohemia in search of the manuscript and Altiero's murderer, but her investigation will lead her all over Europe to Marrakech (where she will make acquaintance of several fascinating men in various cities) and back to Venice where she will confront the murderer in a dramatic showdown.

#### Viola nel Bordeaux

(Viola in the Bordeaux)

Viola and her publisher Stefano Delle Carte are getting mixed up with the murder of a famous wine-grower. Viola, considered by the local police commissaire as one of the suspects, finds out that the circle of top-quality wine passionates and traders is a snake pit; however, other motives could be based on tragic events caused by greed and betrayal in the past, during the German occupation in World War II.

Viola and Stefano Delle Carte spend a weekend at the Château Chabrol, whose owner Etienne Dumas is one of the most famous winemakers. In the last years Dumas has bought many land properties and wine cellars in the surrounding area, sometimes using dubious methods. So, despite his fame he also has several bitter adversaries who, among other things, accuse him of having commercialized the region's wine too much by

sacrificing its characteristic features. His worst enemy Charles Morin is also among the guests of the gourmet weekend, an event which will be crowned by the auction, set for the next day, of the few last bottles of the famous Château Chabrol 1924 which is considered the best wine of the century. The bottles had been found during renovations, behind a wall where the owner had hidden them from Nazi occupation troops. In this alarming situation, a man named Rascasse, who passes himself off t be Morin's confident, offers to help her to prove her innocence. In reality, Rascasse, a man of ambiguous charm, is a petty delinquent, but Viola, despite some doubts, accepts his help. In the course of their investigation they discover that the crimes seem to have their origin in the period of Word War II when the German troops occupied the château ...
